## About Revive2Thrive

Revive2Thrive is Commissioner Garcia's community initiative focused on making Harris County Precinct 2 the best place to live, work, and play. The goal is to invest in improving infrastructure, creating economic opportunities, and enhancing residents' overall quality of life.



## Our Approach

These projects follow a three-step process.

1

### Listen

Engage and listen to the community through stakeholder meetings, public meetings, and online feedback.

2


### Report

# What Is The Milby Street Corridor Study?


The Milby Street Corridor Study is a Harris County Precinct 2 initiative managed by the Harris County Engineering Department.

## PROJECT LIMITS

- Milby Street and Commerce Street from Polk Street to Tony Marron Park, approximately 1.32 miles in Houston's East End.

## PURPOSE OF THE STUDY

- The study will explore corridor improvement concepts that enhance safety, multimodal access, drainage, and connectivity to the East End Bikeway network.







# Tell Us About Your Traffic Flow & Safety

## LEGEND

- LOW CRASH LEVEL (1-5)
- MODERATE CRASH LEVEL (10-15)
- LOW - MID CRASH LEVEL (5-10)
- HIGH CRASH LEVEL (15-20)

- 21% of crashes (11 of 53) occurred during AM PEAK during school entering hours (6am - 8am)
- 19% of crashes (29 of 152) occurred during AM PEAK during school exiting hours (3pm - 5pm)
- 3 accidents that included pedestrians occurred during the date range.


